

VETERINARY CERTIFICATE FOR IMPORT OF DOG/CAT FROM RABIES FREE COUNTRIES* OTHER THAN EU/EFTA COUNTRIES

The Veterinary Certificate consists of Part I (Health Certificate) and Part II (Vaccination Certificate)

*Applies for the following countries: Australia, New Zealand, the U.S. state Hawaii and the Faeroe Islands.

Note! For import to Sweden from other countries than Norway it is required to attain an import permit from The Swedish Board of Agriculture.

Declaration from owner / importer (mark appropriate alternative)

I, the undersigned declare that the dog/cat has only resided in a rabies-free country during the last 6 months or since birth.

The animal will be transported according to international regulations on transport of animals. The animal will be transported **directly** to Norway without coming into contact with other animals. Transit in rabies-infected countries is not allowed, with the exception of transit in the international areas of airports.

Security Clause

The Norwegian Animal Health Authority - Central Unit, may upon short notice and without compensation for the importer prohibit import of dogs and cats if circumstances in the country of despatch or other require such action.

¹ **NOTE!** Import to Norway of dogs of the following breeds (pure-bred or crosses) is prohibited: **Pit Bull Terrier, Fila Brasileiro, Tosa Inu and Dogo Argentino**. Breeds that may be confused with any of the above mentioned breeds, ex. American Staffordshire Terrier, must be able to document through original pedigree certificate and ID-number that the animal is not offspring of prohibited breeds.



PART I HEALTH CERTIFICATE

I, the undersigned authorised veterinarian have today examined and treated the animal and confirm that:

1.	The animal is identified by a decipherable tattoo or microchip which corresponds with the identification given on all documents presented to me.
2.	The animal does not show clinical signs of contagious disease. The owner has assured me that the animal during the last 30 days has not been in contact with other animals that may be suspected of transferring infectious disease.
3.	The animal has been treated for <i>Echinococcus multilocularis</i> with an approved preparation (praziquantel). The owner has assured me that the animal is intended for import to Norway/Sweden within a maximum of 10 days.

(For Norwegian service dogs that have been in service the health certificate (part I) may be replaced by a declaration from the owner/importer).

The Health Certificate (part I) is valid for a period of 10 days after issue.

PART II VACCINATION CERTIFICATE

I, the undersigned authorised veterinarian, confirm that the animal, based upon original vaccination documents and laboratory certificates, fulfils the following animal health requirements:

3.	Brucellosis (applies only to dogs)	
The dog has been tested serologically for brucellosis (<i>Brucella canis</i>) with a negative result. The blood sample was drawn within 21 days prior to importation.		

The Vaccination Certificate (part II) is valid until 365 days after last leptospirosis vaccination, 730 days after last canine distemper vaccination or 21 days after last blood sampling for leptospirosis and brucellosis.
