



Importing Personal Property Into

Jordan

IMPORTING HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL EFFECTS

DUTY-FREE ENTRY IS PERMITTED IF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE MET:

- You are a Jordanian or a foreign citizen coming to the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan with the intent to obtain residency.
- The household goods/personal effects are being imported for personal use.
- The goods must have been used by the owner prior to importation.

Note: Customs Authority approval is required. Duty must be paid on musical instruments, radio sets, refrigerators, carpets, washing machines, furniture and microwave ovens.

DIPLOMATIC REMOVALS:

- Diplomats must be in Jordan prior to the arrival of their shipment.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- ✓ Duty Exemption Certificate from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- ✓ Packing List.
- ✓ The shipper's passport.
- ✓ Lease contract for new home (certified).

RESTRICTED/PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Alcohol and intoxicating liquors
- Firearms, ammunition and explosives
- Narcotics and drugs
- Pornography

IMPORTATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

- Motor vehicles may be imported subject to duties calculated on age, value and engine capacity of vehicle.
