

### Importing Personal Property into

## **ESTONIA**

### IMPORTING HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL EFFECTS

# <u>DUTY-FREE ENTRY IS PERMITTED IF</u> <u>THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE</u> MET:

- The shipper is a returning citizen, a repatriate, is marrying an Estonian citizen, or is a temporary resident.
- Returning citizens must have been abroad for at least 12 months.
- Household goods must have been used by the shipper for at least 6 months prior to importation. This also applies to automobiles.

### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

- Copy of passport
- ✓ Copy of diplomatic card, if applicable
- Documents verifying shipper's status (e.g. for temporary residents, an employment contract; for returning citizens, repatriates and those marrying Estonian citizens, permission from the Migration Office)
- Inventory

### RESTRICTED/DUTIABLE ITEMS

- Pornographic material
- Firearms require special license
- All medications should be hand-carried by the shipper
- Alcohol and tobacco should be handcarried by the shipper or be included in accompanied baggage, and must be limited to 200 cigarettes, 50 cigars, or 250 grams of tobacco; and 1 liter of liquor, 2 liters of wine, or beer up to 175 Euros in value.
