

Importing Personal Property into Turks & Caicos Islands

Personal Effects are allowed into the Turks & Caicos Islands "Duty Free" if they meet the following requirements:

- Goods are solely intended for personal use
- All items are declared upon arrival
- Importer must stay on islands for no less than 12 months from date of entry
- Returning residents must have been away for at least 12 months
- All items must are imported within six months of shipper's entry to islands
- Goods have been owned and used outside of the islands for at least 12 months
- Goods are not sold or disposed of within 12 months of importation
- Non-residents must possess a Work Permit or PRC valid for at least one year. A
 temporary work permit or treasury receipt is not accepted.

Prohibited/Restricted Items

- Illegal Drugs
- Firearms and Explosives
- Pornographic Material
- Alcohol (1.136 Liters are duty free)
- Tobacco (200 cigarettes, 50 cigars OR 225g Tobacco are duty free)
- Gifts (no duty free allowances)
- Agricultural Items
